Meeting Opening

The April 24, 2014 meeting was held at the Jonesborough Pizza parlor in Jonesborough, Tn. There was no speaker today.

The meeting was called to order by President, Danny Young.

The invocation was given by Travis Blevins.

The Secretary/Treasurer, Robert Montgomery was absent due to being out of town on business but, the minutes for March 27, 2014 meeting has been provided to the members by e-mail for review. A motion was made by Dee Morgan to accept the minutes as provided in e-mail form. Tim Earles seconded the motion. The motion to approve the March minutes was passed by all present.

The Treasurers Report was given by President, Danny Young who stated we have a balance of \$6,111.63 in the bank. A motion was made to approve the report by Travis Blevins. It was seconded by Tim Earles. The motion was passed by all present.

Old Business

Education Committee Chair, Jeff Woods reported that the training class arrangements for our fall conference, to be held in Gatlinburg, have been

finalized. It is estimated to cost \$3,360 (based on 50 attendees). We have six vendors lined up so far and have already received two registrations. The hotel has reserved us 40 rooms with a special rate of \$79 per night. The only thing pending at this point in time is making arrangements for the refreshments at the breaks and ordering the books.

New Business

The Scholarship Committee Chair, Karl Cooler reported that only one application was received for reviewed this year. The committee recommends the scholarship be awarded to Hunter Shipley. Hunter is the son of Alan Shipley from Greeneville. A motion to approve the committee recommendation that the award go to Hunter Shipley was made by Jeff Woods. It was seconded by Keith Bruner. The motion was passed by all present. The \$750 award will be presented to Hunter at our next meeting which is scheduled to be held in Greeneville.

Danny Young said he had received a letter requesting our association's support for Bob Boyer for Secretary/Treasurer on the ICC Executive Board. Dewayne Garrison is also running for this same office. It was recommended by Keith Bruner that we should wait until later this fall before we consider who to support. This will be brought back up in our August meeting under old business.

Keith Bruner then led a sometimes lively discussion on various topics dealing mainly with the upcoming TBOA annual meeting and, some possible upcoming state regulatory changes dealing with inspector certifications. No motions were made.

Closing

There were (15) fifteen members present.

Karl Cooler won the door prize.

Travis Blevins reminded everyone that our recently adopted by-laws are now posted on our web-site along with our yearly meeting schedule. He also asked that if anyone knew of any changes or corrections, which may be needed to the site, to contact him so that they could be made.

Tim Earles said he would like to complement everyone for their participation in the discussion during the meeting.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned by President, Danny Young.
