



Eligibility Criteria for the UETBOA Scholarship Program

1. Students of active UETBOA members are eligible. Students must be a legal dependent of a current active member of UETBOA. This includes adopted children, or children living within the home permanently.
2. Overall grade point average achieved in high school should be 2.0 or higher out of a four-point scale as evidence by a high school transcript from his/her teacher, high school, or college.
3. Three letters of recommendation from teachers, professors or advisors detailing work ethic, attitude, cooperation, etc.
4. Proof of awards attained while in high school or college related to academic, citizenship, arts, science, liberal arts, etc. Also, student involvement in community activities such as scouts, clubs, church, etc.
5. Students should have demonstrated a good citizenship record with no prior discipline problems within the school and community. This includes offenses of local, state, and federal laws.
6. Candidates for the scholarship must be graduating high school seniors or attending an accredited college, university or technical school and pursuing an undergraduate degree.
7. The scholarship committee shall interview each candidate and shall base scholarship award on the qualifications and needs of the applicant, considering the following criteria:
 - a. Good Moral Character
 - b. Leadership Qualities
 - c. Scholastic Record
 - d. Seriousness of Purpose
 - e. Promise
 - f. Financial Need

No student will be deprived of this scholarship because of their race, sex, religion, or physical impairment.
